What you can expect from your social worker

The Social Workers Registration Board registers social workers. When we do this, we make sure social workers are suitable to work. All social workers are expected to follow a Code of Conduct. The Code of Conduct is a set of rules or standards that social workers must follow. This helps to keep you and your whānau safe.

The Code says social workers should always work with:

Honesty

Act honestly and ethically

Choices

Help you to make choices based on all the available information

True records

Keep clear and correct records of their work with you

Respect

Respect you and your culture, ethnicity, age, gender, disability, sexuality, faith and beliefs

Privacy

Keep your personal information private safe and confidential

Skills & knowledge

Have the right skills, knowledge and experience to do their job

Support

Support what is in your best interests

If you feel your social worker isn't following the Code, we encourage you to:

- talk to the social worker or
- talk to the social worker's manager or
- talk to the organisation the social worker works for.
